“REMC members across the nation have already sent more than 850,000 messages and the push is on nationwide to send more than 1,000,000 messages” stated Kevin Sump, President and CEO of South Central Indiana REMC. “The Our Energy, Our Future grassroots campaign that we are asking our members to participate in is simply making sure our elected officials are considering ALL of the many issues involved with climate change and assuring our nation continues to have access to reliable, affordable electric service in the future.”

The cooperatives are asking their members to engage their elected officials by asking three basic questions. These questions deal with assuring we have the capacity to meet demand, finding new technologies, and making sure energy remains affordable for consumers. If you go to the SCI REMC website at www.sciremc.com and click on the “Our Energy, Our Future” link the three questions are listed in detail. When you click on this link there is a prepared e-mail letter that can be used. You can, also, edit this text or send a completely different letter. The important thing is to get involved in the debate and make sure your elected officials hear from you.
