



SCI Annual Meeting-September 18, 2010 A message from your CEO



South Central Indiana REMC will hold its 71st annual meeting on Saturday, September 18th at the Mooresville High School in Mooresville, Indiana. Registration begins at 8:00 AM and a free breakfast will be served from 8:00 AM to 9:30 AM. The business meeting will be called to order at 9:45 AM. A free children's program will also be available during the meeting.

Each member attending the meeting will receive \$10 and will be eligible to win one of twenty-five \$100 bills that will be given away during the business meeting. All members attending the meeting are eligible to sign up for the very popular water heater program. This program provides you with the opportunity to purchase an energy efficient water heater any time prior to the 2011 annual meeting. It is a great insurance policy should your water heater fail during the next year. This special offer does require the installation of a Demand Response Unit (DRU) on your water heater.
