AVOIDED RATE FOR SMALL POWER GENERATION SYSTEMS

RATE SCHEDULE - SPGS

EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 2014

Availability

Available to any consumer of the corporation with a Small Power Generation System (SPGS) up to a maximum of 50 KW contracting for parallel operation in accordance with the Cooperative's rules and regulations. The SPGS must be located adjacent to an electric line of the Cooperative that is adequate for the service to be provided by the SPGS. The additional generation must not violate SCI REMC's all power requirements contract with Hoosier Energy REC.

Small Power Generation System

Small Power Generation System shall include any cogeneration or small production facility, including renewables, with a nameplate rating up to 50 KW.

Contract

The SPGS shall enter into a contract before operating any generating equipment electrically connected to the Cooperative's system.

Rate for Purchase of Energy

The Cooperative will purchase energy from the SPGS in accordance with the conditions and limitations of the contract at the following rate:

Winter Months (December – February)

For all KWH supplied per month – on-peak	\$.296930 per KWH
For all KWH supplied per month – intermediate	\$.078570 per KWH

Summer Months (June – August)

For all KWH supplied per month – on-peak	\$.461830 per KWH
For all KWH supplied per month – intermediate	\$.078570 per KWH

Rest of the Year (March-May and September-November)

For all KWH supplied per month – on-peak	\$.089870 per KWH

All Year

For all KWH supplied per month – off-peak \$.045690 per KWH

On-peak period will be as follows:

Winter Months

7:00AM-9:00AM and 6:00PM-8:00PM EST weekdays, excluding December 25th and January 1st.

Summer Months

5:00PM-8:00PM EDT weekdays excluding July 4th.

Rest of Year

7:00AM-9:00AM and 6:00PM-8:00PM weekdays

Intermediate Periods:

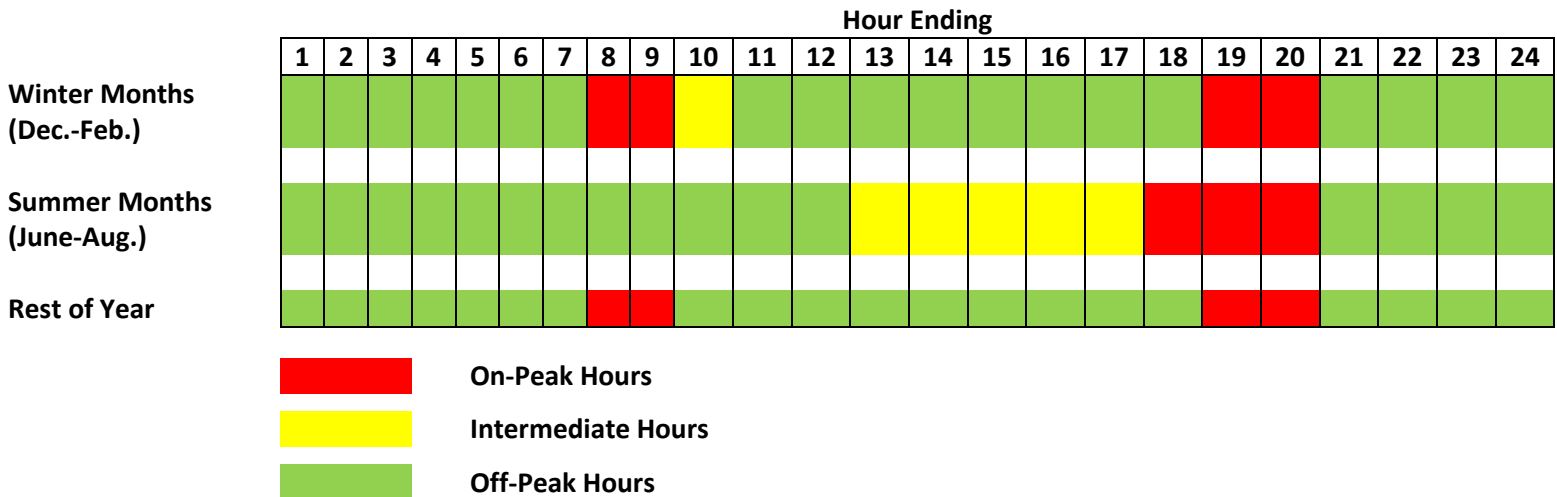
Winter Months

9:00AM-10:00AM EST weekdays, excluding December 25th and January 1st.

Summer Months

12:00PM-5:00PM EDT weekdays excluding July 4th.

Off-peak periods will be all hours other than the on-peak hours and intermediate hours described above.



Hoosier Energy Adjustment

The above rates may be subject from time to time to a purchased power cost adjustment tracking factor as deemed appropriate by the Board of Directors of the Corporation. The purchased power cost adjustment tracking factor applicable hereto is shown in Appendix A.

Parallel Operation

The Cooperative will permit a SPGS to operate in parallel with the Cooperative's distribution system per the Cooperative's *Member Requirements for Installation and Interconnection of Small Power Systems 50 KW or Less* and the *Agreement for Interconnection of Small Power Generation Systems*. The agreement must be executed prior to interconnection with the Cooperative's distribution system.

Maintenance, Supplementary and Backup Power

The Cooperative will provide all power required by its member for the Maintenance, Supplementary, and Backup Power requirements of the SPGS pursuant to the Cooperative's applicable retail rate schedule.

Interpretation of Schedule

The interpretation of or the application by the Cooperative or by any member of all rates, rules, and regulations included in this rate schedule shall be subject to review by the Board of Directors of the Corporation, consistent with its service rules and regulations or policies, except as otherwise provided by law.

Rate Schedule Modifications

All rate schedules and charges, as well as the Cooperative's service rules and regulations or policies, may be amended or modified, in whole or in part, at any time as deemed appropriate by the Corporation's Board of Directors.
