

2021 RESIDENTIAL REBATE PROGRAM

About the Program

Your electric cooperative is offering a 2021 residential rebate for qualifying equipment (water heaters, geothermal heat pumps and air source, ductless mini-split or dual fuel heat pumps). To qualify, you must occupy the home where equipment is installed year-round (12 months) and unit must heat and cool whole home unless otherwise stated.

Please provide the following documents to your electric cooperative to apply for possible rebates*:

- AHRI (Air conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration Institute) certificate for validation for all SEER ratings. (This can be obtained from the installing heating and cooling dealer.)
- 2021 Residential Rebate Application
- Proof of purchase (invoice or receipt)
- Before and after photos

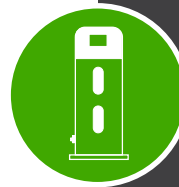

Should the applicant receive power from any source other than the electric cooperative, including generation owned by the customer, before the end of the equipment's deemed useful life, the applicant agrees to refund the full amount of the rebate to the distribution cooperative.
10. Applicant gives permission to Hoosier Energy to obtain usage information from their electric cooperative. Applicant understands that Hoosier Energy may use the usage information provided for program evaluation and analysis. If signing in a capacity other than an individual capacity, the individual signing below hereby represents and warrants that s/he is duly authorized to execute and deliver this application on behalf of the applicant.

Limit of two rebates per household. Rebates for HVAC equipment are available for whole home installations only unless otherwise stated. To receive a rebate, all homeowners must provide AHRI (Air conditioning, Heating and Refrigeration Institute) validation for all SEER and EER ratings that can be obtained from the installing heating and cooling dealer. No rebate will be awarded based on HVAC dealer bid specifications, promotional material of dealer, manufacturer or any other source than AHRI. A certificate of AHRI-certified performance must be submitted.

All homeowners must complete a rebate application form and provide proof of purchase to receive any 2021 rebate. **Deadline to apply for 2021 Rebate Program is Dec. 15, 2021.**

The cooperative reserves the right to approve, deny or select the appropriate rebate. The co-op also reserves the right to inspect and verify installation of equipment receiving a rebate.
