

2023 CAMP KILOWATT SELECTION PROCESS

June 7 – 10, 2023

Applications due March 1, 2023

SCI REMC will sponsor 3 students at the annual Camp Kilowatt. The camp will be held June 7-10, 2023, at Camp Tecumseh in Brookston, Indiana.

Camp Kilowatt is a three-night, four-day overnight camp hosted at Camp Tecumseh in Brookston, Indiana. Students will meet at Camp Tecumseh the afternoon of June 7 and immediately jump into fun activities and start making new friends. Each year, the camp committee works to develop a well-rounded schedule to strike a balance between education and fun. Activities include a live line safety demonstration, bucket truck rides, an electrical pole climbing tutorial, and various activities involving circuit boards, renewables, and even internet safety. Camp Kilowatt also includes tons of fun camp outdoor activities. Program highlights include swimming, canoeing, other lake activities, zip lining, archery, horseback riding, a climbing wall, field games, and of course – a campfire and hotdogs.

This experience is geared toward 6th students (who will be entering the 7th grade the school year following the camp), whose parents or guardians are SCI REMC members, and who meet all the requirements.

CAMP KILOWATT RULES:

1. The student must be in the 6th grade (who will be entering the 7th grade the school year following the camp).
2. The student's parent or guardian must be a member of SCI REMC.
3. The student must complete the entry form and submit a written paragraph response to the given question by the program deadline of March 1.

HOW TO APPLY:

1. Complete the entry form at campkilowatt.org
2. Answer the question below with a small paragraph (at least 50 words).
3. Paragraphs must be typed on an 8 ½" x 11" or letter-size page.
4. Paragraph submissions must include the student's name, address, and telephone number.
5. Email your paragraph to cooperativerelations@sciremc.com with the Subject: 2023 Camp Kilowatt Submission.

Question:

"What would you like to learn at Camp Kilowatt?"

Evaluation and Selection:

A panel of 3 judges will evaluate and rank the essays. Criteria for judging will be as follows:

1. Strength of ideas – 60% Includes recognizable point being made, solid support of your view
2. Style – 20% Includes originality of approach, appealing presentation
3. Writing usage/grammar – 20% Includes correct use of words, punctuation, spelling, and sentence structure.

The top three finalists will be selected to attend Camp Kilowatt, sponsored by SCI REMC.

Note: Should any of the top three finalists be unable to attend Camp Kilowatt, a runner-up (in the order of scoring) will be contacted.
