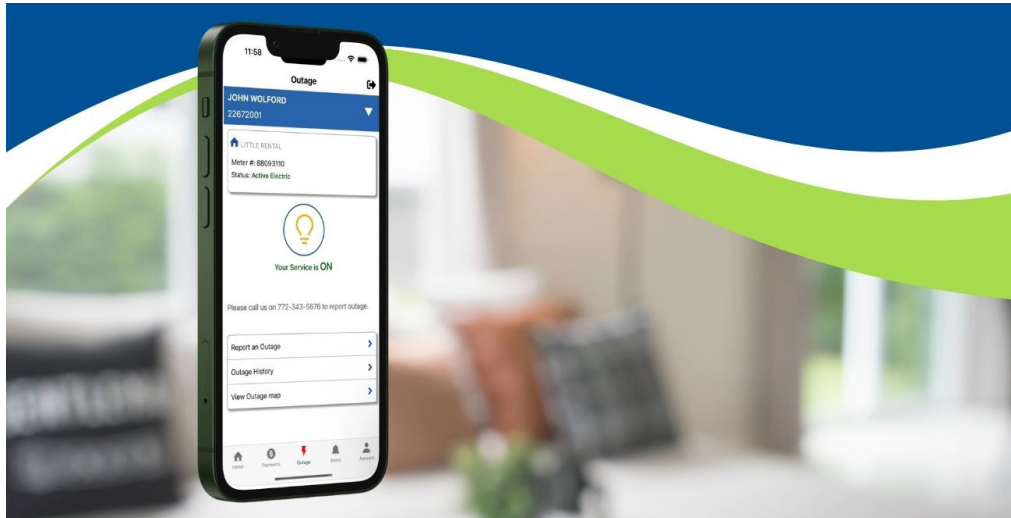

## Stay Connected

### USING THE SCI CONNECT APP TO MANAGE YOUR ELECTRIC ACCOUNT

We understand how important it is for our members to stay informed about their electric account and energy usage. That's why SCI REMC offers several convenient tools to help you track usage, monitor outages, and manage account activity - all in one place.

### TRACK ENERGY USAGE

With the SCI Connect app, members can easily monitor their energy usage right from their phone. The Usage Tracker displays your daily electricity use in kilowatt-hours (kWh) and even shows the day's recorded temperature. This feature makes it easier to understand how weather impacts your energy consumption. For example, if temperatures drop below freezing, your heating system may work harder, which can increase your usage.

### SET ALERTS

The Alerts section of the app can help you catch unusual energy usage early. You can customize alerts to notify you if your energy use exceeds a set amount. This is especially helpful if a backup system turns on unexpectedly or if space

heaters are running for long periods of time and increasing your usage. If you notice a spike, our contact center representatives are always available to help you identify potential causes.

You can also set up billing alerts, including reminders for bill due dates, notifications if a draft payment fails, or confirmations after a payment is made.

### MAKE PAYMENTS

The SCI Connect app also makes managing payments simple. You can pay your bill directly from your phone, review your billing history, and even schedule future payments. Your monthly statement, just like the one mailed to your home, is also available to view within the app.

### REPORT OUTAGES

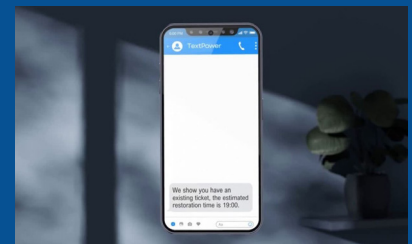
The app provides a convenient place to report outages, review your outage history, and view the outage map. It can also show whether power is currently on at your home, giving you quick insight during an outage event.

## Power Out? SEND A TEXT

When the power goes out, getting updates shouldn't be difficult. That's why South Central Indiana REMC offers TextPower, a convenient outage notification program that keeps you informed right from your phone.

With a simple text, you can quickly report an outage and receive confirmation and restoration updates throughout the event. **Just text "OUTAGE" to 765.505.7005 and follow the prompts to report your outage.**

Want an update? Text **"STATUS"** to check restoration progress. If you ever wish to stop receiving messages, simply text **"STOP."** It's a fast, easy way to stay connected when it matters most.

# Be mindful when driving through work zones

## FOLLOW THESE TIPS FOR DRIVING THROUGH WORK ZONES TO KEEP LINEWORKERS AND YOURSELF SAFE.

Watch for orange work zone signs, flaggers, and vehicles with flashing lights.

Slow down and be prepared for sudden stops.

Never stop in the roadway. This can trigger rear-end collisions.

Indiana's "move over" law requires drivers to change lanes when approaching emergency vehicles stopped along the roadway if it is safe. If not, drivers must reduce speed and proceed with caution. While the law specifically applies to emergency vehicles, motorists should extend the same courtesy to all roadside workers.

The time saved by speeding is minimal — traveling two miles at 65 mph instead of 45 mph only saves **ONE MINUTE.**

Violations carry **STEEP PENALTIES.**

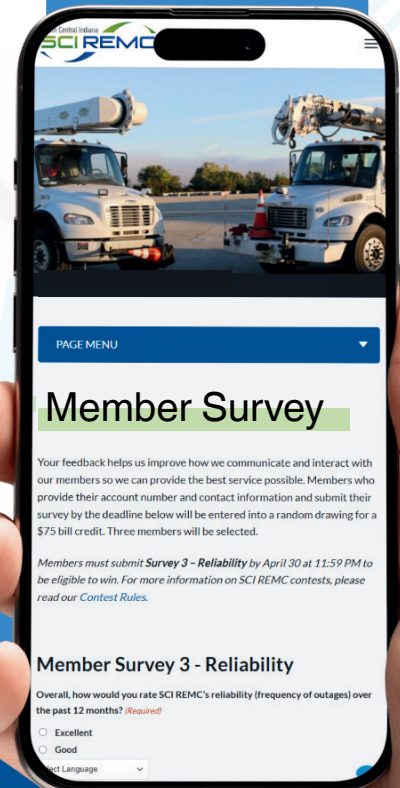
