2024 Director Election

Members will receive ballots by mail and email (if provided on member's account) to vote for the director seats up for election this year. Voting can be done either by mail or online, but members are limited to one vote each. We encourage all members to vote for one candidate from each district, regardless of where you reside.

A total of 1,000 online voters and 500 paper ballot voters will be randomly selected to receive a \$15 bill credit. Additionally, all members who vote by the deadline will be entered for a chance to win one of fifty \$100 bill credits.

GET SMART, GET CONNECTED!

Connect to Save from SCI REMC Saves Money and Energy.



When temperatures outside reach their highest and lowest, everyone's HVAC systems require more energy to maintain a stable indoor temperature. This can lead to an energy rush hour called peak demand. During times of peak demand, your cooperative may need to purchase more power than anticipated, which can be costly.

By enrolling in the Connect to Save program, you allow SCI REMC to remotely adjust your smart thermostat during these peak demand periods. This helps SCI REMC and Hoosier Energy avoid purchasing more power, and in exchange, participants earn an annual incentive!



How Does Connect to Save Work?

Participating members will receive a notification a few hours in advance of an adjustment. Then, using a wi-fi connection, the cooperative will slightly adjust the temperature on your thermostat. The temperature will never be changed by more than 4 degrees and never for longer than four hours at a time.

However, participating members retain control of their devices. You can always adjust the thermostat yourself, and SCI REMC won't adjust it again until the next event.

On top of receiving an annual incentive, members will receive \$75 for each device they enroll!
